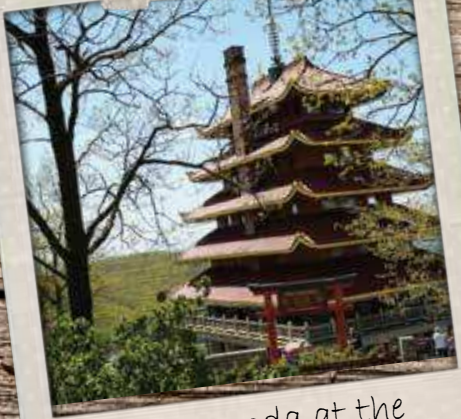

Antietam Lake

A 643 acre county-owned park that offers all levels of cyclists the opportunity to explore roughly 25 miles of technical trails. With single and double track riding, these cross country, mountain and gravity trails will occupy riders for hours on end as they climb and descend the lake side of Mt. Penn.

Blue Marsh

A 23 mile trail -Inner Loop, and 30 mile -Outer Loop, surrounds this scenic 1,147 acre lake. Pack a lunch and plenty of water. A cross-country biker's / runner's / hiker's dream come true.

French Creek State Park

A strenuous workout along 30 miles of difficult trails that allows bikers to explore the 7,730 acre park. Perfect for intermediate and advanced riders, the park offers double track and fire roads for beginners.

Mt. Penn

Skyline Drive divides this mountain into two sections. The "City Side" has traversing trails and contain some enduring climbs. The "Back Side" features the popular 0.7 mile **A-Line downhill run** with flow, rollers, berms, and 15 jumps with go-arounds, in addition to a network of miles of trails for all riders, runners, and hikers.

Neversink Mountain

Be sure to enjoy the trails while being captivated by amazing vistas and learning local history at every turn. The old Gravity R.R. bed wraps around the mountain and forms the main trail. Look closely, and you'll be treated to some fine single track. See you at the "Witch's Hat".

Schuylkill River Trail

Voted as the Best Urban Trail in the country by USA Today, it is the main artery connecting all of the trail systems in the Greater Reading region. It can be accessed from various points, including as far away as Philadelphia and welcomes all skill levels.

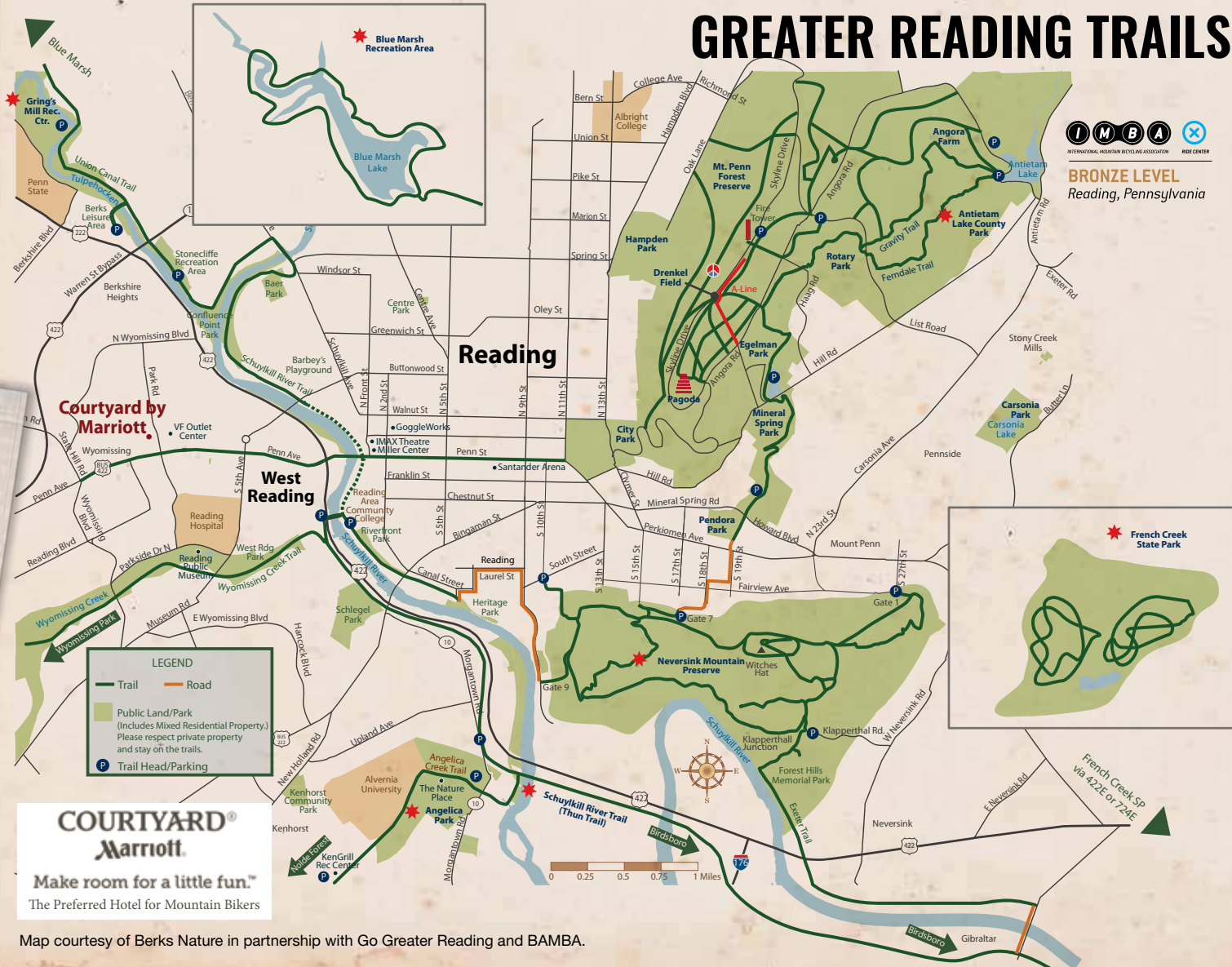
